



The Restoration Agreement

Thank you for choosing **Orange County Hotrods** for the restoration of your collectible automobile. It is our desire that the process of restoring your car will be an enjoyable and satisfying one.

In order to provide guidance for the process of restoring automobiles for our customers, the following policies have been developed to minimize ambiguities during the restoration.

1. Because of the comprehensive nature of the restoration process, specific estimates or “bids” of the total cost of a restoration project cannot be given at any time. As much as I would love to give you an estimate on how much it will cost, that what is needed to be done for the vehicle, it is simply impossible to do so, therefore we operate on an hourly basis. A general estimate can be given to you for costs, so you can see where your budget stands, but given unexpected fixes that may need addressing as we dig into your car, extra costs do occur.
2. A deposit is required at the time of the signing of this agreement and scheduling to have the car delivered to our facility to await commencement of the work to be done. Deposit amount will be determined at the time of signing. The deposit will be applied to work performed and parts and materials consumed until it is depleted.
3. As of **May 1, 2020**, General Labor and Fabrication rates are **\$105.00** per hour. Vehicle pick up and or drop off is **\$150.00** each way up to 30 miles. After 30 miles a charge of **\$15.00** each additional 10 miles will incur.
4. Invoices reflecting work performed and the amount of your deposit used will be sent twice per month. The billing cycle periods are as follows: 1st through the 15th and 16th through the end of each month.
5. Types of payment accepted are: Cash, Check, Credit Card and Debit Card. Credit and Debit card payments are subject to a **3%** processing fee. The **3%** is calculated based on the amount of payment.
6. Restoration charges apply to “Time and Materials”. Quality, comprehensive restorations of collectible automobiles take time, and will be expensive. A list of parts and materials used within the billing cycle is included on the invoice.

7. Invoices will include an item titled "Consumables" also known as "Shop Supplies" which include such items such as cleaning solvents, rags, sealant, tape, paper, miscellaneous nuts, bolts, etc. This cost will be **3%** of the labor cost of the current invoice.
8. All parts, materials and outside service work will be marked up a flat **15%** to cover transportation and administrative costs.
9. Insurance on the vehicle while in possession of Orange County Hotrods is the responsibility of the Owner of the vehicle.
10. At no time will customer be allowed to perform any work on their own vehicle while vehicle is located on the Orange County Hotrod business premises.
11. In the event a customer initiates a "hold" on work, a **\$200.00** per month storage fee will be assessed until a new deposit is received. If the car is completed and left at the shop, after 2 weeks a charge of **\$35.00** per day will be assessed.
12. The customer may at any time remove the vehicle upon payment of all outstanding invoices. Vehicles are not released until account balances are paid in full.
13. Finally, all recommendations for your classic car, from parts to modifications, repairs etc., are opinions based on our experiences as a Hot Rod (Restoration) Builder. We will not accept liability for our opinions; however, we will accept responsibility for giving you the best professional advice we know possible.

We always recommend asking any questions that you may have. As a builder, we will keep detailed documentation done to your car each week, that it is worked on, which includes any written reports, photos and invoices.
